



**BOARD OF ALDERMEN REGULAR MEETING MINUTES**  
**October 22, 2025 at 7:00 p.m.**

The October 22, 2025 Regular Meeting of the Marthasville Board of Alderman was held at Marthasville City Hall and called to order at 7:00 PM with Mayor David Lange, presiding. Mayor Lange led the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was taken by Alderman Lange. Alderman Meyer, Alderman DeVore, Alderman Dixon, Alderman Lange and Mayor David Lange. After roll call, Mayor Lange reported a quorum was present. Also present at the meeting were Mark Piontek (City Attorney), William Carroll from the Warren County Record.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Mayor Lange added #7 to the agenda under new business - Bollards at South Street bridges. Alderman Meyer made a motion to approve the agenda with adding #7 Bollards at South Street bridges. Alderman Lange seconded the motion. All aldermen present voted "aye", and the motion passed 4-0.

Alderman Dixon made the motion to approve the regular BOA meeting minutes from 9.17.2025. Alderman Meyer seconded the motion. All Alderman present voted "aye" and motion passed 4-0 vote.

  - Alderman Meyer asked about still waiting on Ameren to relocate poles.
  - Mayor Lange mentioned they are looking into possibly paving the lot in between the old grocery store and Philllys. It belongs to the City.



## NEW BUSINESS

### 7. BOLLARDS AT SOUTH STREET BRIDGES

- Mayor Lange mentioned that the board voted to close the two bridges at 2 and 4 Street. Dave Griffin placed removable bollards there.
- Mayor Lange said that he and Dave Griffin discussed putting big planters there instead. It would be a lot cheaper and easy to move if need be.
- Alderman Lange said he has seen several complaints about the temporary bollards being on the bridges and residents wanting to know when they will be opening back up.
- Alderman Lange against closing 2 and 4 Street bridges unless deemed unsafe by engineer.
- Alderman DeVore said that they were closed as temporary test for flow of traffic.
- Alderman Lange made a motion to remove temporary bollards off 2 and 4 Street until deemed unsafe by engineer and review at that time. Alderman Dixon seconded the motion. All Alderman present voted "Aye". Motion passed with a 4-0 vote.

## EXECUTIVE SESSION

- Mayor Lange requested a motion to close the public meeting and go into executive session. Alderman Meyer made a motion to end public session and enter into executive session pursuant to Section 610.022 RSMo for the purpose of dealing with matters relating to the following: 610.022(1) relating to legal actions, causes of action, litigation and privileged communications between the City's representatives and its legal counsel; 610.022(2) relating to leasing, purchasing or sale of real estate; 610.022(3) relating to the hiring, firing, discipline and promotion of an employee of the City or any other matters as authorized under Chapter 610 RSMo. Alderman DeVore seconded the motion. All aldermen present voted "aye" by roll call vote and motion passed with a 4-0 vote. Mayor Lange then verbally read the above. Public meeting adjourned at 7:39p.m. and then entered executive session after a five-minute recess.
- Alderman Lange made a motion to end executive session and re-enter into public session. Alderman Dixon seconded the motion. All alderman present voted via role call vote and the motion passed 4-0. Executive session ended at 8:11p.m.

## VOTE TO ADJOURN REGULAR MEETING

- Alderman Lange made a motion to end the public session, and Alderman Dixon seconded the motion. All aldermen present voted "Aye" and the motion passed 4-0. Meeting was adjourned at 8:11pm.
