



BOARD OF ALDERMEN REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
February 18, 2026 at 7:01 p.m.

The February 18, 2026 Regular Meeting of the Marthasville Board of Alderman was held at Marthasville City Hall and called to order at 7:01 PM with Mayor David Lange, presiding. Mayor Lange led the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was taken by Ravin Kersting, City Clerk. Alderman Meyer, Alderman DeVore, Alderman Dixon, Alderman Lange and Mayor David Lange. After roll call, Mayor Lange reported a quorum was present.

Also present at the meeting were Mark Piontek (City Attorney), William Carroll from the Warren County Record and Don Deeker (316 S. Sixth St), Sarah & Alex Scroggins (913 Tanglewood Dr) and Raquel & Cooper Carver (125 Crestview Dr).

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Alderman Lange made a motion to approve the agenda, and Alderman Meyer seconded the motion. All aldermen present voted "aye", and the motion passed 4-0 vote.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Alderman Dixon made the motion to approve the regular BOA meeting minutes from 01.21.2026. Alderman Meyer seconded the motion. All Alderman present voted "aye" and motion passed 4-0 vote.

1. MAYOR LANGE

2. MONTHLY BILLS/FINANCIAL REPORT

- Alderman Lange made a motion to approve the monthly bills and financial reports. Alderman Dixon seconded the motion. All Alderman present voted "Aye". Motion passed with a 4-0 vote.

5. RUSCHE PARK BOARD

- Don Deeker commented that there was no January meeting due to weather and Kathy will have Rusche Park open on the 1st Sunday of each month.

6. STREET PROJECTS- DEPOT AND 5th Street

- Mayor Lange mentioned 5th Street concrete is completely done and now they are working at the end of Hiawatha St.
- Mayor Lange mentioned that they fixed the sidewalk by the church.
- Alderman DeVore stated that he would like to look into curb and gutter on Two and Three St by the park.



- Alderman DeVore also discussed the N W Corner of Main and Two St, the overgrown tree/bush that makes it hard to see there. It was discussed to talk with the owner John Day about removing it.

NEW BUSINESS

7. DON DEEKER

- Don Deeker spoke about this July 4th being the 250th year old of our nation and he would like for the City of Marthasville to celebrate. He is looking for the approval and support of the City.
- Mayor Lange said that he was contacted by Bryan Burns to do something as well. He will be giving Don Deeker Bryans contact info so they can get together on this.
- Alderman Lange spoke aloud and said that Don will have the City's approval and support along with Bryan Burns.

8. FLYNN DRILLING/MAINTENANCE CONTRACT

- Mayor Lange went over with the Board of Alderman the water supply pumping equipment inspection agreement. This agreement discusses a once-a-year inspection for wells 2 and 3 by Flynn Drilling Company for \$750.00.
- Alderman Meyer made a motion to approve the inspection agreement with Flynn Drilling for wells 2 and 3. Alderman Dixon seconded the motion. All Alderman present voted "Aye". Motion passed with a 4-0 vote.

9. BILL #469 AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR BUDGET 2024-2025

- Mayor Lange asked for a motion for a 1st and 2nd reading of Bill 469; Alderman Lange made a motion for the 1st and 2nd reading, seconded by Alderman Meyer; All Alderman present voted "Aye". Roll call vote was taken.
- Mayor Lange read the 1st and 2nd reading of Bill #469.
- Alderman Lange motioned to approve Bill #469; seconded by Alderman Meyer; all Alderman present by roll call vote voted "Aye".
- Bill #469 is now Ordinance #469.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

- Mayor Lange requested a motion to close the public meeting and go into executive session. Alderman Meyer made a motion to end public session and enter into executive session pursuant to Section 610.022 RSMo for the purpose of dealing with matters relating to the following: 610.022(1) relating to legal actions, causes of action, litigation and privileged communications between the City's representatives and its legal counsel; 610.022(2) relating to leasing, purchasing or sale of real estate; 610.022(3) relating to the hiring, firing, discipline and promotion of an employee of the City or any other matters as authorized under Chapter 610 RSMo. Alderman DeVore seconded the motion. All aldermen present voted "aye" by roll call vote and motion passed with a 4-0 vote. Mayor Lange then verbally read the above. Public meeting adjourned at 7:46 p.m. and then entered executive session after a five-minute recess.
- Alderman Lange made a motion to end executive session and re-enter into public session. Alderman DeVore seconded the motion. All alderman present voted via roll call vote and the motion passed 4-0. Executive session ended at 8:20p.m.

VOTE TO ADJOURN REGULAR MEETING

- Alderman Lange made a motion to end the public session, and Alderman DeVore seconded the motion. All aldermen present voted "Aye", and the motion passed 4-0 vote.
- Meeting was adjourned at 8:21pm.
