

BOARD OF ALDERMEN REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
July 17, 2024 at 7:01p.m.

The July 17, 2024 Regular Meeting of the Marthasville Board of Alderman was held at Marthasville City Hall and called to order at 7:01 PM with Mayor David Lange, presiding. Mayor Lange led the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was taken by Ravin Kersting, Deputy Clerk. Alderman Leo Meyer, Alderman Dixon, Alderman DeVore and Mayor David Lange were present. Alderman Lange was not present. After roll call, Mayor Lange reported a quorum was present. No visitors from the public were present.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Alderman Meyer made a motion to approve the agenda.

Alderman Dixon seconded the motion. All aldermen present voted "aye" and the motion passed 3-0.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Alderman Meyer – Reported he had received a call from Bryan Niemeyer stating he has a tree that fell over and wanting to know if the City can clean it up. Alderman Meyer said that he told Bryan that the tree is not on City property, and we can't clean up everyone's trees.

Mentioned the concrete truck that sits on Griswald St. and wanting to know why the City is allowing that? Mayor Lange said that he would discuss this issue with the truck owner.

Alderman DeVore – Asked for an update on the Tahoe and 1-ton vehicles and if we had gotten anywhere with that? Mayor Lange said that they have not been advertised yet as the City is still using them on the current street projects and once they are done being used we will proceed further.

Asked for an update with the cameras at City Hall and the park. Mayor Lange reported that Ra-Comm has sent us back an updated quote.

- Discussed the flood in town that took place on July 16th. He said that he doesn't follow social media much, but there were several comments made and when and if necessary, he will address those.
- Discussed Bryan Niemeyer's tree issue again and that the City can't clean up everyone's trees.

- Alderman Meyer made a motion to approve the June 2024 monthly bills and financial reports. Alderman Dixon seconded the motion. All Alderman present voted "Aye". Motion passed with a 3-0 vote.

6. WATER LINE REPORT

7. STREET PROJECT

- Mayor Lange mentioned that this is still being worked on around all the rain, concrete was poured, and David is staying on top of it and saving the City a ton of money.

NEW BUSINESS

8. SXS/VEHICLES ON STREET

- Mayor Lange announced that he has spoken with Warren County Sherriff, Kevin Harrison on complaints of kids on off-road vehicles (SXS, 4-wheeler, dirt bike, etc.). Kevin told Mayor Lange that he has given his guys the ok to start having a towing company in Warrenton tow the off-road vehicles if this is their 2nd or 3rd warning. Parents then will have to get them back from the towing lot.
- Alderman DeVore suggested maybe the City doing something regarding this issue. Mayor Lange suggested that anyone seeing an issue needs to just call Warren County and they will handle it.

9. LIQUOR LICENSES

- Alderman Meyer made a motion to approve liquor licenses for Philly's Pizza and Maverick's Diner. Alderman DeVore seconded the motion. All alderman present voted "aye" and the motioned passed 3-0.

EXECUTIVE SESSION


- Alderman Meyer requested to go into Executive Session. Mayor Lange requested a motion to close the public meeting and go into executive session. Alderman DeVore made a motion to end public session and enter into executive session pursuant to Section 610.022 RSMo for the purpose of dealing with matters relating to the following: 610.022(1) relating to legal actions, causes of action, litigation and privileged communications between the City's representatives and its legal counsel; 610.022(2) relating to leasing, purchasing or sale of real estate; 610.022(3) relating to the hiring, firing, discipline and promotion of an employee of the City or any other matters as authorized under Chapter 610 RSMo. Alderman Lange seconded the motion. All aldermen present voted "aye" by roll call vote and motion passed with a 3-0 vote. Mayor Lange then verbally read the above. Public meeting adjourned at 7:58 p.m. and then entered into Executive Session after a five-minute recess.

VOTE TO ADJOURN REGULAR MEETING

- Alderman Meyer made a motion to end the public session and Alderman DeVore seconded the motion. All aldermen present voted "aye" and the motion passed 3-0. Meeting was adjourned at 8:15p.m.
