

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DERELICT
VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF MARTHASVILLE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of
Marthasville, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION I. No person shall leave any partially dismantled,
non-operating, wrecked, unlicensed or junked vehicle on any street or
highway within the City.

SECTION II. No person in charge or control of any property
within the City, whether as owner, tenant, occupant, lessee, or
otherwise, shall allow any partially dismantled, non-operating,
wrecked, unlicensed or junked vehicle to remain on such property
longer than ninety (90) days after the City Council of Marthasville
shall have mailed notification to such person regarding such vehicle.
Actual receipt of such notification is not required for a violation of
this Section.

SECTION III. Sections I and II of this Ordinance shall not
apply to a vehicle in a building enclosed on all sides with a roof and
not visible to the public.

SECTION IV. Unless the context specifically indicates
otherwise, the meaning of terms in this Ordinance shall be as follows:

A. "Vehicle" shall mean a device or
structure for transporting persons or things, a conveyance, and or self-
propelled conveyance that runs on tires, a motor vehicle.

B. "Unlicensed" shall mean any vehicle that
is not displaying valid and current tags or plates that are required by
the State of Missouri to operate said vehicle.

SECTION V. Notification of a violation of this Ordinance may
be made by the Clerk of the City of Marthasville by registered mail to
such person regarding such vehicle. Actual receipt of such
notification is not required for a violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION VI. Each day that any such person allows any such
vehicle to remain in violation of this Ordinance shall be considered a
separate offense hereunder.

SECTION VII. The penalty for each vehicle in violation of this
Ordinance will be a fine of a minimum of \$10.00 and a maximum of
\$100.00 per violation plus court costs.

SECTION VIII. All ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict
with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IX. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage by the Board of Aldermen.
