

ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION TO PARK ANY HOUSE TRAILER OCCUPIED AS LIVING QUARTERS OR OTHER IMPERMANENT HOUSING UPON ANY LOT OR TRACT OF LAND WITHIN THE CITY OF MARTHASVILLE, MISSOURI, WITHOUT FIRST SECURING A PERMIT THEREFOR FROM THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN, AND PROVIDING THAT APPLICATION FOR SUCH PERMIT MUST BE FILED WITH THE CITY CLERK.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Marthasville, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to stop, stand or park any house trailer occupied as living quarters or other impermanent housing upon any lot or tract of land within the City of Marthasville, Missouri, outside of a legally established trailer court, without first securing a written permit therefor from the Board of Aldermen of said city.

SECTION 2. Every applicant for such permit shall file with the City Clerk a written application setting forth a description of the house trailer or other impermanent housing, the proposed location therefor, the number of persons to occupy the same, and the length of time to be so occupied.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the passage and approval hereof.
